11	An Act relating to the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act; prohibiting public officers and employees from using
12	public monies to promote certain policies; providing list of prohibited actions; providing certain
13	exclusions; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24.5 of Title 51, unless there
19	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	A. A public officer or the employees of a public officer shall
21	not use public monies, or cause public monies to be used for the
22	advocacy or promotion of policies contrary to the Oklahoma Self-
23	Defense Act or the Oklahoma Firearms Act of 1971 and shall be
24	specifically prohibited from doing any of the following:

1 1. Using publicity for purposes of advocating or promoting policies contrary to the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act or the Oklahoma 2 Firearms Act of 1971 or preparing, distributing, or using any kit, 3 pamphlet, booklet, publication, electronic communication, or radio, 4 5 television, or video presentation designed to support or defeat the enactment of legislation, an ordinance, rule, regulation, or 6 administrative action relating to policies contrary to the Oklahoma 7 Self-Defense Act or the Oklahoma Firearms Act of 1971; 8

9 2. Paying the salary or expenses of any grant or contract 10 recipient or agent acting on behalf of the recipient, if the grant 11 or contract is related to any activity designed to influence the 12 enactment of legislation, an ordinance, rule, regulation, or 13 administrative action relating to policies contrary to the Oklahoma 14 Self-Defense Act or the Oklahoma Firearms Act of 1971; or

3. Advocating or promoting any proposed, pending, or future 15 federal, state, or local tax increase relating to policies contrary 16 to the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act or the Oklahoma Firearms Act of 17 1971, or any proposed, pending, or future requirement or restriction 18 on any legal consumer product including the sale and marketing of 19 the legal consumer product relating to the advocacy or promotion of 20 policies contrary to the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act or the Oklahoma 21 Firearms Act of 1971. 22

B. The provisions of this section shall not apply to:
