10 FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act;
12 prohibiting public officers and employees from using
13 public monies to promote certain policies; providing
14 list of prohibited actions; providing certain
15 exclusions; providing for codification; and providing
16 an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24.5 of Title 51, unless there
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 A. A public officer or the employees of a public officer shall
22 not use public monies, or cause public monies to be used for the
23 advocacy or promotion of policies contrary to the Oklahoma Self-
24 Defense Act or the Oklahoma Firearms Act of 1971 and shall be
specifically prohibited from doing any of the following:

1 1. Using publicity for purposes of advocating or promoting
2 policies contrary to the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act or the Oklahoma
3 Firearms Act of 1971 or preparing, distributing, or using any kit,
4 pamphlet, booklet, publication, electronic communication, or radio,
5 television, or video presentation designed to support or defeat the
6 enactment of legislation, an ordinance, rule, regulation, or
7 administrative action relating to policies contrary to the Oklahoma
8 Self-Defense Act or the Oklahoma Firearms Act of 1971;

9 2. Paying the salary or expenses of any grant or contract
10 recipient or agent acting on behalf of the recipient, if the grant
11 or contract is related to any activity designed to influence the
12 enactment of legislation, an ordinance, rule, regulation, or
13 administrative action relating to policies contrary to the Oklahoma
14 Self-Defense Act or the Oklahoma Firearms Act of 1971; or

15 3. Advocating or promoting any proposed, pending, or future
16 federal, state, or local tax increase relating to policies contrary
17 to the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act or the Oklahoma Firearms Act of
18 1971, or any proposed, pending, or future requirement or restriction
19 on any legal consumer product including the sale and marketing of
20 the legal consumer product relating to the advocacy or promotion of
21 policies contrary to the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act or the Oklahoma
22 Firearms Act of 1971.

23 B. The provisions of this section shall not apply to:
24

1 1. Any person elected to a state, county, or municipal office
2 or any person who is appointed to fill a vacancy in a state, county,
3 or municipal office;

4 2. Any person presenting neutral testimony on behalf of an
5 organization; or

6 3. Any person stating a personal opinion while presenting
7 testimony and the person is not testifying in his or her official
8 capacity.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
