



1 (AASHTO) requesting that the section of Historic U.S. Route 66 that  
2 travels through this state be designated as a U.S. Bicycle Route.

3 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4019.1 of Title 69, unless there  
5 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 On or before November 1, 2021, the Oklahoma Department of  
7 Transportation shall sign and then send a completed application to  
8 the American Association of State Highway and Transportation  
9 Officials (AASHTO) to request that the organization designate the  
10 section of Historic U.S. Route 66 that travels through this state as  
11 a U.S. Bicycle Route. If the application is accepted and Historic  
12 U.S. Route 66 is designated as a U.S. Bicycle Route, the Department  
13 shall cause suitable permanent markers marking the route to be  
14 placed on the highway.

15 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
