11 An Act relating to schools; amending Section 1,
12 Chapter 141, O.S.L. 2020 (70 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section
13 27-104), which relates to emergency medical services
14 at athletic events or activities; changing act name
15 to Riley's Rule; requiring development of an
16 Emergency Action Plan; specifying contents of plan;
17 providing for annual review, update and rehearsal of
18 plan; requiring digital transmission of plan prior to
19 certain athletic events; and providing an effective
20 date.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 141, O.S.L.
23 2020 (70 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 27-104), is amended to read as
24 follows:

 Section 27-104. A. This act shall be known and may be cited as
~~the "Riley Boatwright Act"~~ "Riley's Rule".

1 B. Prior to the beginning of the ~~2020-2021~~ 2021-2022 school
2 year, each school district board of education shall coordinate with
3 ~~the~~ emergency medical services ~~provider~~ providers that ~~serves~~ serve
4 the area in which the school district is located to develop ~~a plan~~
5 an Emergency Action Plan for ~~the provision of emergency medical~~
6 ~~services at~~ each facility and athletic practices, events or
7 activities held at school district facilities.

8 C. ~~The plan developed pursuant to subsection B of this section~~
9 Emergency Action Plan shall:

10 1. Include maps and directions with appropriate contact
11 information for emergency medical services;

12 2. Assign a medical administrator who is a current school
13 employee such as a coach, administrator or athletic director;

14 3. Define responsibilities and personnel onsite, both medical
15 and school officials;

16 4. Include a list of medical equipment available and location
17 of the nearest automated external defibrillator, if available;

18 5. Be posted in each facility;

19 6. Be distributed to all school officials involved in athletic
20 practices, events or activities held at school district facilities;

21 and

22 7. Specify documentation actions after any emergency to
23 evaluate for debriefing purposes and to determine if there are
24 necessary changes to the Emergency Action Plan.

1 D. The Emergency Action Plan shall be reviewed and, updated and
2 rehearsed annually as appropriate, prior to the start of season
3 practices, with school officials and local emergency medical
4 services providers, and placed on file with the school district and
5 the emergency medical services provider.

6 E. Prior to each athletic event or activity where there are
7 athletes participating from visiting schools, the Emergency Action
8 Plan shall be digitally transmitted to the visiting school
9 administrator or coach.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
