13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1210.711 of Title 70, unless
15	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	All students attending public schools in the state shall receive
17	counseling and guidance services from certified school counselors.
18	Each school district shall provide one certified school counselor
19	for not more than two hundred fifty students, with no school
20	district having less than one certified school counselor who is
21	employed at least half-time.
22	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
