

1 2. Burning or destroying of property, ~~or the unlawful~~
2 interference;

3 3. Interference with a police officer, peace officer, fireman
4 or a member of the Oklahoma National Guard or any unit of the armed
5 services officially assigned to riot duty in the lawful performance
6 of his or her duty;

7 4. Obstruction of an exit or entrance into a private business;
8 or

9 5. Obstruction of any street, road, highway or thoroughfare in
10 this state used by the public.

11 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1320.11 of Title 21, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 A motor vehicle operator who unintentionally causes injury or
15 death to an individual shall not be criminally or civilly liable for
16 the injury or death, if the injury or death of the individual
17 occurred while the motor vehicle operator was fleeing from a riot,
18 as defined in Section 1311 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes,
19 under a reasonable belief that fleeing was necessary to protect the
20 motor vehicle operator from serious injury or death.

21 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
