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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-103.7a of Title 70, unless
19	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	A. As used in this section, "social-emotional learning" is the
21	process through which children and adults understand and manage
22	emotions, set and achieve positive goals, feel and show empathy for
23	others, establish and maintain positive relationships and make
24	responsible decisions.

1	B. Beginning in the 2022-2023 school year, each school district
2	in the state may provide age-appropriate instruction of social-
3	emotional learning at the option of the local school district.
4	C. The State Department of Education may create or offer
5	accurate instructional materials for social-emotional learning
6	education on the Department's website. A school district may elect
7	to create or implement its own social-emotional learning education
8	instructional materials.
9	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
