17	Notwithstanding any other provision of the law, the State Board
18	of Education shall issue a one-year alternative teacher certificate,
19	renewable for up to three (3) years, to teach early childhood
20	education or elementary education to any qualified candidate who:
21	1. a. Has successfully completed a terminal degree, such as
22	a doctorate of philosophy, a doctorate in education,
23	professional doctorates, a master of fine arts degree
24	or a master of library science degree, from an

institution accredited by a national or regional 1 accrediting agency which is recognized by the 2 Secretary of the United States Department of 3 Education. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall be consulted to verify other terminal 5 degrees, or 6

b. Holds at least a baccalaureate degree from an 7 institution whose accreditation is recognized by the 8 9 Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and has 10 two (2) years postdegree-completion qualified work experience in a field that corresponds to early 11 12 childhood education or elementary education; and 13 2. Declares the intention to earn standard certification by means of the early childhood and elementary education alternative 14 15 certification program in not more than three (3) years and has:

within the first year satisfactorily completed six (6) 16 a. 17 credit hours in classroom management and reading instruction from an educator preparation program 18 19 approved and accredited by the Commission for 20 Educational Quality and Accountability, completed the 21 required State Department of Education approved 22 training on cognitive science of how students learn to 23 read and participated in a yearlong mentorship or 24 instructional coaching in reading and classroom

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management provided by the employing school district prior to the renewal of the provisional certificate for a second year,

within the second year satisfactorily completed six b. 4 (6) credit hours in child development and math 5 instruction from an educator preparation program 6 approved and accredited by the Commission for 7 Educational Quality and Accountability, participated 8 9 in an additional yearlong mentorship and/or 10 instructional coaching in child development and math 11 instruction provided by the employing school district 12 prior to the renewal of the provisional certificate 13 for a third year, and successfully completed the general education and subject area portions of the 14 competency examination required in Section 6-187 of 15 Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes in the area of 16 17 specialization for which certification is sought, and within the third year satisfactorily completed six (6) 18 с. 19 additional credit hours of professional education coursework from an educator preparation program 20 21 approved and accredited by the Commission for 22 Educational Quality and Accountability, participated 23 in an additional yearlong mentorship and/or 24 instructional coaching provided by the employing
