



1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3032 of Title 2, unless there is  
3 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 As used in this act:

5 1. "Vegetable garden" means a piece of property wholly located  
6 within a person's residential property that is used to grow produce,  
7 flowers, herbs, fungi, or grains for one's own consumption and  
8 enjoyment and not for resale or distribution; and

9 2. "Residential property" means real property on which there is  
10 a dwelling unit with accommodations for four or fewer separate  
11 households and is further limited to the primary residence of a  
12 person.

13 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3033 of Title 2, unless there is  
15 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 Except as otherwise provided by law, a county, municipality, or  
17 other political subdivision of this state may not regulate vegetable  
18 gardens on residential properties. Any such local ordinance or  
19 regulation regulating vegetable gardens on residential properties is  
20 void and unenforceable.

21 This section does not preclude the adoption of a local ordinance  
22 or regulation of a general nature that does not specifically  
23 regulate vegetable gardens, including, but not limited to,  
24

1 regulations and ordinances relating to water use during drought  
2 conditions, fertilizer use, or control of invasive species.

3 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
