13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2021, Section 509, is

16 Section 509. A. The Oklahoma Department of Corrections is

~~18. Clara Waters and Kate Barnard Community Corrections Centers shall be located at Center in Oklahoma City in Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma; and the~~

~~19. Lawton Community Corrections Center shall be located at in Lawton in Comanche County, State of Oklahoma; and the~~

~~20. Enid Community Corrections Center shall be located at in Enid in Garfield County, State of Oklahoma; and the~~

~~21. Union City Community Corrections Center shall be located at in Union City in Canadian County, State of Oklahoma; and the~~

~~22. Charles E. "Bill" Johnson Correctional Center shall be located east of in Alva in Woods County, State of Oklahoma; and the Washita Valley Correctional Center shall be located at Pauls Valley in Garvin County, State of Oklahoma; and said institutions and community corrections centers are hereby established within the Department. Said.~~

B. The Department shall be the legal successor of and, except as otherwise provided in the Oklahoma Corrections Act of 1967, shall have the powers and duties vested by law in the Office of Management and Enterprise Services in all matters relating to penal institutions, heretofore or hereafter established by the Department,

1 which institutions and community corrections centers shall be under
2 the administrative direction and control of the Department.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
