16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1110 of Title 60, unless there
19	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	The state shall limit the amount of public land owned by the
21	State of Oklahoma, state agencies, and federal government to no more
22	than ten percent (10%) of the total land in the state.

1	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1110 of Title 60, unless there
3	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
4	A. All easements granted to or reserved by the federal
5	government, on or after the effective date of this act, for land
6	located in the state of Oklahoma shall be for a period of thirty
7	(30) years or less.
8	B. All easements granted to or reserved by the State of
9	Oklahoma or state agencies shall be for a period of thirty (30)
10	years or less. Any easements held by the State of Oklahoma or any
11	state agency that has been owned by the state or any state agency
12	for longer than thirty (30) years are hereby released and
13	relinquished.
14	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
