17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified	
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-103.60 of Title 70, unless	
19	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:	
20	A. Beginning in the 2022-2023 school year, Holocaust education	
21	shall be taught in all public schools in a manner that:	
22	1. Generates an understanding of the causes, course, and

- 2. Develops dialogue with students on the ramifications of bullying, bigotry, stereotyping, and discrimination; and
- 3. Encourages tolerance of diversity and reverence for human ignity for all citizens in a pluralistic society.
- B. The State Board of Education, in consultation with experts in Holocaust education, shall develop and distribute curricula, materials, and units related to Holocaust education for grade-appropriate instruction for students in grades six through twelve.
- C. As used in this section, "Holocaust" means the systematic, state-sponsored persecution and attempted annihilation of Jews and other groups by the Nazi regime in Germany between 1933 and 1945, which resulted in the murder of approximately six million (6,000,000) Jews and five million (5,000,000) other individuals.
 - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
