8 An Act relating to public safety; providing for
9 special designation for certain drivers; providing
 for codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1136A of Title 47, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The Department of Public Safety shall design and create a
17 designated license plate for deaf and hearing-impaired drivers.
18 These drivers shall have the option to use these specially
19 designated license plates.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
