11 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

12 An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety;
13 requiring that certain funds be utilized for certain
14 purposes; providing budgeting and expenditure
15 limitations and procedures; providing for lapse of
16 funds under certain conditions; requiring and
17 prohibiting certain budget procedures; and providing
18 for noncodification.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
20 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

21 From the funds appropriated to the Department of Public Safety
22 in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the 58th
23 Oklahoma Legislature, the Department of Public Safety is hereby
24 authorized to expend Fourteen Million Two Hundred Thirty-one

1 Thousand Dollars (\$14,231,000.00) to provide a pay increase to
2 commissioned law enforcement officers of the Oklahoma Highway
3 Patrol.

4 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
5 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

6 From the funds appropriated to the Department of Public Safety
7 in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the 58th
8 Oklahoma Legislature, the Department of Public Safety is hereby
9 authorized to expend Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) to
10 provide a pay increase to persons serving as Communications
11 Dispatchers for the Department of Public Safety.

12 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
13 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

14 From the funds appropriated to the Department of Public Safety
15 in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the 58th
16 Oklahoma Legislature, the Department of Public Safety is hereby
17 authorized to expend One Hundred Sixty-four Thousand Dollars
18 (\$164,000.00) to provide a pay increase to persons providing
19 security services at the Oklahoma Capitol building.

20 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
21 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

22 From the funds appropriated to the Department of Public Safety
23 in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the 58th
24 Oklahoma Legislature, the Department of Public Safety is hereby

1 authorized to expend One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars
2 (\$150,000.00) to create and maintain the Mental Wellness Division as
3 described in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1613 of the 2nd Session of the
4 58th Oklahoma Legislature.

5 SECTION 5. Appropriations made by this act, not including
6 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
7 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23) or may be
8 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 (hereafter FY-24).
9 Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only through June 30,
10 2023, and must be expended by November 15, 2023. Any funds
11 remaining after November 15, 2023, and not budgeted for FY-24, shall
12 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
13 year. Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered only through June
14 30, 2024. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2024, shall lapse
15 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
16 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
17 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-23, and not required to pay
18 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-24, after
19 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
20 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
21 from the FY-23 budget work program and after such revision has been
22 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
