9	A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State to refer to the people for their approval or
10	rejection a proposed amendment to Section 8C of Article X of the Constitution of the State of
11	Oklahoma; modifying provisions related to certain qualifying income limits; providing ballot title; and
12	directing filing.
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14	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
15	1ST SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
16	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
17	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
18	the following proposed amendment to Section 8C of Article X of the
19	Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:
20	Section 8C. A. Despite any provision to the contrary,
21	beginning January 1, $\frac{2005}{2023}$, the fair cash value, as determined
22	by law, on each homestead of an individual head of household $rac{whose}{whose}$
23	gross household income from all sources for the preceding calendar
24	year did not exceed an amount as provided in subsection B of this

1 section, and which individual head of household is sixty-five (65) 2 years of age or older, shall not exceed the fair cash value placed upon the property during the first year in which the individual head 3 of household was sixty-five (65) years of age or older and had gross 4 5 household income from all sources which did not exceed an amount as 6 provided in subsection B of this section. Subject to the 7 limitations of this section, the fair cash value shall not exceed 8 such amount as long as the individual head of household who is 9 sixty-five (65) years of age or older owns and occupies the property 10 and as long as the gross household income from all sources does not exceed an amount as provided in subsection B of this section. 11 Ιf 12 any improvements are made to the property, the fair cash value of 13 the improvements shall be assessed in accordance with law by the 14 county assessor and added to the assessed value of the property. 15 Once the fair cash value of the improvements has been added to the 16 fair cash value of the property, the total fair cash value shall not 17 exceed the revised valuation of the property so long as the 18 individual head of household who is sixty-five (65) years of age or 19 older owns and occupies the property and so long as the gross 20 household income from all sources does not exceed an amount as 21 provided in subsection B of this section. For any individual head 22 of household who is sixty-five (65) years of age or older prior to 23 January 1, 1997, and has gross household income from all sources of 24 Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) or less in calendar year

1 1996, the fair cash value of the real property shall be the fair 2 cash value placed upon the property on January 1, 1997. If the individual head of household ceases to own and occupy the property 3 4 or if the gross household income from all sources exceeds an amount 5 as provided in subsection B of this section, the fair cash value of the property shall be determined as if the provisions of Section 8 6 of Article X of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma or any 7 other provisions relating to a limitation on the fair cash value of 8 9 locally assessed real property had been in effect during the time 10 the property was valued pursuant to the provisions of this section. 11 B. The income threshold for the gross household income from all 12 sources for an individual head of household under this section shall 13 not exceed the amount determined by the United States Department of 14 Housing and Urban Development to be the estimated median income for 15 the preceding year for the county or metropolitan statistical area 16 which includes such county. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall 17 provide such information to each county assessor each year as soon 18 as such information becomes available. 19 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional 20 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in

24 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

1 This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It amends Section 2 8C of Article 10. This section prevents increases in the fair 3 cash value of the homestead of persons age sixty-five (65) or 4 older. Currently, to avoid an increase in the fair cash value 5 of the homestead property, the person cannot have a gross 6 household income greater than a certain amount determined each 7 year using information about household income published by the 8 United States Department of Housing and Urban Development. This 9 measure would eliminate the qualifying income limit and the fair 10 cash value of the homestead owned by a person age sixty-five 11 (65) or older could not increase as long as the person occupied 12 the property as their homestead. 13 SHALL THE PROPOSAL BE APPROVED? 14 FOR THE PROPOSAL - YES 15 AGAINST THE PROPOSAL - NO 16 SECTION 3.
