9       An Act relating to crime and punishment; amending 21  
10      O.S. 2021, Section 650.8, which relates to felony  
11      assault, battery or assault and battery upon employee  
12      of facility; allowing for certain felony offense; and  
13      providing an effective date.

14   BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15       SECTION 1.        AMENDATORY        21 O.S. 2021, Section 650.8, is  
16   amended to read as follows:

17       Section 650.8.   A.   Every person who, without justifiable or  
18   excusable cause, knowingly commits any assault, battery or assault  
19   and battery upon the person of an employee of a facility maintained  
20   by the Department of Human Services, a facility maintained by a  
21   private contractor pursuant to a contract with the Department of  
22   Human Services, or upon the person of an employee of a facility  
23   maintained by the Office of Juvenile Affairs, a facility maintained  
24   by a private contractor pursuant to a contract with the Office of

1 Juvenile Affairs primarily for delinquent children, a juvenile  
2 detention center, or a juvenile bureau, while the employee is in the  
3 performance of his duties, shall, upon conviction, ~~thereof~~ be guilty  
4 of a felony.

5 B. This section shall not supersede any other act or acts, but  
6 shall be cumulative thereto.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
