9 An Act relating to students; requiring school
10 districts and charter schools to include certain
11 information on student identification cards; allowing
12 certain information to be included on student
13 identification cards; stating legislative intent that
14 certain institutions of higher education include
15 certain information on student identification cards;
16 allowing issuance of certain non-compliant
17 identification cards until a supply is depleted;
18 providing for application; providing for
19 codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-100.10 of Title 70, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Beginning July 1, 2023, school districts and charter schools
that serve any students in grades seven through twelve and issue
student identification cards shall have printed on either side of
the student identification cards the telephone number described in

1 paragraph 1 of this subsection and may have printed on either side
2 of the student identification cards the telephone number described
3 in paragraph 2 of this subsection:

4 1. The National Suicide Prevention Lifeline, which can be
5 accessed by calling or texting 988; and

6 2. The Crisis Text Line, which can be accessed by texting HOME
7 to 741741.

8 B. It is the intent of the Legislature that beginning July 1,
9 2023, institutions within The Oklahoma State System of Higher
10 Education and private institutions of higher education in the state
11 that issue student identification cards may print on either side of
12 the student identification cards the telephone numbers described in
13 paragraphs 1, 2, and 3 of this subsection:

14 1. The National Suicide Prevention Lifeline, which can be
15 accessed by calling or texting 988;

16 2. The Crisis Text Line, which can be accessed by texting HOME
17 to 741741; and

18 3. The campus police or security telephone number or, if the
19 campus does not have a campus police or security telephone number,
20 the local nonemergency telephone number.

21 C. If a school district or charter school subject to the
22 provisions of subsection A of this section or an institution of
23 higher education subject to the provisions of subsection B of this
24 section has a supply of unissued student identification cards that

1 do not comply with subsections A and B of this section, as
2 applicable, as of July 1, 2023, the school or institution of higher
3 education may issue the non-compliant student identification cards
4 until the supply is depleted.

5 D. Subsections A and B of this section shall apply to a student
6 identification card issued for the first time to a student and to a
7 student identification card issued to replace a damaged or lost
8 student identification card.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
