AMENDATORY 15 amended to read as follows: 16 Section 1137.3. The purchaser of every new and used motor 17 vehicle, travel trailer or commercial trailer shall register or 18 license the same within thirty (30) days from the date of purchase 19 20 sixty (60) days from the date of purchase for purchases made on or after the effective date of this act. It shall be the 21 responsibility of the selling dealer to place a temporary license 22 plate, in size similar to the permanent Oklahoma license plate but 23 of a weatherproof plastic-impregnated substance approved by the 24

1 Oklahoma Motor Vehicle Commission, upon a new motor vehicle, travel trailer or commercial trailer when a transaction is completed for 2 3 the sale of said the vehicle or trailer. Except for cab and chassis trucks, the temporary license plate under this section shall be 4 5 placed at the location provided for the permanent motor vehicle license plate. The purchaser of a new cab and chassis truck may 6 place the temporary license plate under this section in the rear 7 window. Said The temporary license plate shall show the dealer's 8 9 license number which is issued to him or her each year by the Oklahoma Tax Commission, the date the new motor vehicle, travel 10 trailer or commercial trailer was purchased and the company name of 11 12 the selling dealer. The Oklahoma Motor Vehicle Commission is hereby 13 directed to develop a temporary license plate design to incorporate these requirements in a manner that will permit law enforcement 14 personnel to readily identify the dealer license number and date of 15 the vehicle purchase. The Motor Vehicle Commission is further 16 authorized to develop additional requirements and parameters 17 designed to discourage or prevent illegal duplication and use of the 18 temporary license plate. On or before sixty (60) days from the date 19 of purchase for purchases made on or after the effective date of 20 this act and before July 1, 2023, and thirty (30) days from the date 21 of purchase of a new motor vehicle, travel trailer or commercial 22  $trailer_{T}$  for purchases made before the effective date of this act, 23 said the temporary license plate shall be removed and replaced with 24

a permanent, current Oklahoma license plate. Use of said the temporary license plate by a licensed dealer for other than the purpose of normally doing business shall constitute grounds for revocation of the dealer's license.

It shall be unlawful for any licensed dealer of new motor vehicles, travel trailers or commercial trailers to procure the registration and licensing of any new motor vehicle, travel trailer or commercial trailer sold by such licensed dealer or to act as the agent for such purchaser in the procurement of said the registration and licensing. The license of any licensed dealer of new motor vehicles, travel trailers or commercial trailers violating the provisions of this section shall be revoked.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
