



1        2. The provisions of paragraph 1 of this subsection shall not  
2 apply to retail implement dealers, as defined in Section 581 of this  
3 title.

4        B. No person shall operate an escort vehicle for hire, as  
5 required by this section, unless the person has been certified by  
6 the Department of Public Safety as an escort vehicle operator.

7        C. Any person not required to be certified by the Department of  
8 Public Safety as an escort vehicle operator may tow a trailer when  
9 escorting a manufactured home. Such trailer shall not exceed eight  
10 and one-half (8 1/2) feet in width and twenty (20) feet in length  
11 with siding not to exceed four (4) feet in height measured from the  
12 bed of the trailer.

13        The trailer may only be used to transport supplies and equipment  
14 necessary to carry out the mission of escort vehicle operators.

15        D. The Commissioner of Public Safety shall promulgate rules for  
16 the certification of operators of escort vehicles and the use of  
17 escort vehicles, as required by this section.

18        E. The Commissioner of Public Safety is hereby authorized to  
19 enter into reciprocal compacts and agreements with other states for  
20 the purpose of recognizing escort vehicle operator certifications  
21 issued by those states.

22        SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
23 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
24

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
