16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 139.204 of Title 17, unless
19	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	A. The Oklahoma Department of Commerce with the participation
21	and advice of the Rural Broadband Expansion Council shall promulgate
22	rules and procedures for the establishment of the State Broadband
23	Deployment Grant Program. The State Broadband Deployment Grant
24	Program shall include development of a competitive grant program to

1 award funding to applicants seeking to expand access to broadband Internet service in this state. The Department and Council shall 3 look at best practices in other states to help facilitate the framework of the Program. 5 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Oklahoma Department of Commerce to be designated the 6 7 "State Broadband Deployment Grant Program Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall 9 consist of all monies designated for deposit to said fund. 10 monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated 11 and may be budgeted and shall be expended by the Department for the 12 purpose of awarding grants by and through the Rural Broadband Expansion Council, pursuant to subsection A of this section, to 13 applicants seeking to expand access to broadband Internet service in 14 15 this state.
