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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 53 O.S. 2021, Section 201C, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 201C. A. The J.M. Davis Memorial Commission shall have
16	power and authority to:
17	1. Appoint and to fix the salaries and duties of the
18	professional and administrative employees and curators as may be
19	necessary to carry out the purpose of this act;
20	2. Appoint an executive director who shall serve at the
21	pleasure of the Commission. A member of the Commission may be
22	appointed as the executive director; provided, if a member of the
23	Commission is so appointed, the member shall resign as a member of

3	3. Provide for the proper housing, protection and display of
4	the J.M. Davis Gun Collection and other historical artifacts; and
5	4. Enter into contracts for services to be performed in
6	furtherance of the authorized activities and duties of the J.M.
7	Davis Memorial Commission with other state agencies or nonprofit
8	corporations holding a valid exemption from taxation issued pursuant
9	to Section 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended,
10	and listed as an exempt organization in Section 501(c)(3) of the
11	Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or with individuals or
12	associations pursuant to statutory requirements.
13	B. Funds of the J.M. Davis Memorial Commission shall not be
14	applied, donated, or used directly or indirectly for the use,
15	benefit, or support of any sect, church, denomination, or system of
16	religion, or for the use, benefit, or support of any priest,
17	preacher, minister, or other religious teacher or dignitary, or
18	sectarian institution as such. The J.M. Davis Memorial Commission
19	shall provide opportunity to organizations to submit written
20	applications to be received and acted upon by the J.M. Davis
21	Memorial Commission. At the conclusion of the contract, each state
22	agency, nonprofit corporation, individual, or association shall
23	provide the J.M. Davis Memorial Commission with proof of fulfillment
24	of the contract in proper order and must be affirmed on the proper

1 <u>form, provided by the J.M. Davis Memorial Commission, by the</u>
2 <u>managing officers of the state agency, nonprofit group, association,</u>
3 or individual making the contract.

<u>C.</u> Any agreements or contracts providing for the employment of
persons or to purchase property or equipment or the construction of
any facilities shall not be authorized unless necessary funds have
been appropriated by the Legislature or have been otherwise obtained
from gifts, grants or contributions actually received by the
Commission.

10 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 53 O.S. 2021, Section 201G, is 11 amended to read as follows:

12 Section 201G. A. The J.M. Davis Memorial Commission is authorized to sell or transfer museum collection objects, which are 13 duplicates or are outside of the scope of collections owned by it, 14 to other state agencies or other museums with nonprofit status or to 15 commercial entities or individuals unless the object is leased to or 16 loaned to the Commission or was purchased with appropriated funds by 17 the Commission. Transfers shall not be to individuals or commercial 18 entities. Any transfer or sale shall be in full compliance with the 19 laws and regulations regarding the sale of such objects, including 20 laws and regulations regarding the sale of firearms. The proceeds 21 of any sale or transfer shall be deposited in the J.M. Davis Arms 22 and Historical Museum Endowment Fund, or the J.M. Davis Memorial 23 Commission Revolving Fund as determined by a vote of the Commission. 24

SENATE FLOOR VERSION - HB3124 SFLR (Bold face denotes Committee Amendments) B. The J.M. Davis Memorial Commission shall be exempt from the
Oklahoma Surplus Property Act for the purpose of disposing of museum
collection surplus property as described in subsection A of this
section and is authorized to destroy and dispose of museum
collection surplus property including objects owned by the
Commission that have deteriorated past the point of usefulness or
have no resale value.

8 C. No past or present member of the J.M. Davis Memorial 9 Commission, current employee, <u>or</u> their families, volunteer, or 10 member of the Friends of the J.M. Davis Museum, Inc. or its 11 successor may obtain possession of museum collection surplus 12 property from the Commission in person or by proxy <u>unless obtained</u> 13 at a public sale under the provisions of this section.

D. The J.M. Davis Memorial Commission shall not transfer, or dispose of any property that is leased to, loaned to, or held in temporary custody by the Commission.

17 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
