18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 427.3A of Title 63, unless there
21 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
23 for the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority to be designated the
24 "County Sheriff Public Safety Grant Revolving Fund". The fund shall
be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and
shall consist of all monies received by the Oklahoma Medical
Marijuana Authority that are appropriated or apportioned to this

1 fund, and any federal funds, grants, and donations from any public
2 or private source for the purpose of supporting county sheriffs.
3 All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby
4 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma
5 Medical Marijuana Authority for the purpose of establishing programs
6 and providing funding to support county sheriffs to enforce the
7 requirements of state law with respect to the commercial growth of
8 medical marijuana or other related business activity for which a
9 license is required pursuant to the provisions of law governing the
10 production, cultivation, transportation, distribution, sale, or
11 other actions related to medical marijuana. Expenditures from the
12 fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer
13 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the
14 Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and
15 payment.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.

17 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
18 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
