9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 36 O.S. 2011, Section 6060, as
11 amended by Section 1, Chapter 158, O.S.L. 2018 (36 O.S. Supp. 2020,
12 Section 6060), is amended to read as follows:

13 Section 6060. A. For the purposes of this section 7:

14 1. "Health benefit plan" means any plan or arrangement as
15 defined in subsection C of Section 6060.4 of this title;

16 2. "Low-dose mammography" means:

17 a. the x-ray examination of the breast using equipment
18 specifically dedicated for such purpose, with an
19 average radiation exposure delivery of less than one
20 rad mid-breast and with two views for each breast,

21 b. digital mammography, or

22 c. breast tomosynthesis; and

23 3. "Breast tomosynthesis" means a radiologic mammography
24 procedure involving the acquisition of projection images over a

1 stationary breast to produce cross-sectional digital three-
2 dimensional images of the breast from which breast cancer screening
3 diagnoses may be made.

4 B. All health benefit plans shall include the coverage
5 specified by this section for a low-dose mammography screening for
6 the presence of occult breast cancer. ~~Such~~ If a female's previous
7 low-dose mammography screening demonstrated dense breast tissue, as
8 defined in this subsection, the plan shall cover a four-dimensional
9 breast magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) in lieu of a low-dose
10 mammography screening. As used in this paragraph, "dense breast
11 tissue" means heterogeneously dense tissue or extremely dense tissue
12 as defined in the Breast Imaging and Reporting Data System
13 established by the American College of Radiology.

14 C. The coverage required pursuant to subsection B of this
15 section shall not:

16 1. Be subject to the policy deductible, co-payments and co-
17 insurance limits of the plan; ~~or~~

18 2. Require that a female undergo a mammography screening at a
19 specified time as a condition of payment; or

20 3. Be subject to pre-authorization from the insurer.

21 ~~C.~~ D. 1. Any female thirty-five (35) through thirty-nine (39)
22 years of age shall be entitled pursuant to the provisions of this
23 section to coverage for a low-dose mammography screening, or a four-
24

1 dimensional breast MRI pursuant to the provisions of subsection B of
2 this section, once every five (5) years.

3 2. Any female forty (40) years of age or older shall be
4 entitled pursuant to the provisions of this section to coverage for
5 an annual low-dose mammography screening, or a four-dimensional
6 breast MRI pursuant to the provisions of subsection B of this
7 section.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
