12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 650.8, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Section 650.8. A. Every person who, without justifiable or
15	excusable cause, knowingly commits any assault, battery or assault
16	and battery upon the person of an employee of a facility maintained
17	by the Department of Human Services, a facility maintained by a
18	private contractor pursuant to a contract with the Department of
19	Human Services, or upon the person of an employee of a facility
20	maintained by the Office of Juvenile Affairs, a facility maintained
21	by a private contractor pursuant to a contract with the Office of
22	Juvenile Affairs primarily for delinquent children, a juvenile
23	detention center, or a juvenile bureau, while the employee is in the
24	

1	performance of his duties, shall, upon conviction, thereof be guilty
2	of a felony.
3	B. This section shall not supersede any other act or acts, but
4	shall be cumulative thereto.
5	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
