NEW LAW 14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 223 of Title 15, unless there is 15 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 16 A person who sells or offers to sell merchandise or a 17 service for any specified period under a contract containing a 18 provision for automatic renewal shall: 19 20 1. Present the terms of the automatic renewal offer in proximity to the offer in a clear and conspicuous manner before a 21 subscription or purchasing contract may be fulfilled; 22 2. Provide an acknowledgement that includes the terms of the 23

automatic renewal offer and information regarding how to cancel the

- 1 automatic renewal in a manner which is capable of being retained by 2 the buyer; and
  - 3. Provide a cost-effective, timely and simple procedure for cancellation of the automatic renewal which shall be described in the acknowledgement required pursuant to paragraph 2 of this subsection.
  - B. A person who sells or offers to sell merchandise or a service for a specified period under a contract containing a provision for automatic renewal for a period that exceeds six (6) months at the end of the time period specified in the contract shall provide a clear and conspicuous written notice to the purchaser stating that the purchaser may cancel the contract and avoid automatic renewal. Any contract for sale of merchandise or a service in violation of the requirements of this section shall be void and unenforceable and any merchandise or service provided to the purchaser shall be considered an unconditional gift. The Attorney General may enforce the requirements of this section, and a person aggrieved by a violation of this section may bring an action for restitution and injunctive relief.
  - C. The provisions of this section shall not apply to a contract for insurance.
