8 An Act relating to gun control; prohibiting public  
9 officers and employees from using public monies to  
10 promote gun control; providing list of prohibited  
actions; providing for codification; and providing an  
effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24.5 of Title 51, unless there  
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A public officer or the employees of a public officer shall not  
18 use public monies, or cause public monies to be used for the  
19 advocacy or promotion of gun control policy and shall be  
20 specifically prohibited from doing any of the following:

21 1. Using publicity or propaganda for purposes of advocating or  
22 promoting gun control policy or preparing, distributing, or using  
23 any kit, pamphlet, booklet, publication, electronic communication,  
24 or radio, television, or video presentation designed to support or

1 defeat the enactment of legislation, an ordinance, rule, regulation,  
2 or administrative action relating to gun control policy;

3 2. Paying the salary or expenses of any grant or contract  
4 recipient or agent acting on behalf of the recipient, if the grant  
5 or contract is related to any activity designed to influence the  
6 enactment of legislation, an ordinance, rule, regulation, or  
7 administrative action relating to gun control policy; or

8 3. Advocating or promoting any proposed, pending, or future  
9 federal, state, or local tax increase relating to gun control  
10 policy, or any proposed, pending, or future requirement or  
11 restriction on any legal consumer product including the sale and  
12 marketing of the legal consumer product relating to the advocacy or  
13 promotion of gun control policy.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
