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1 individuals and those individuals appointed or not appointed by a 2 law enforcement agency may attend the courses or training offered by 3 the technology center school or higher education institution. CLEET shall vote to approve or deny an application to offer courses or 4 5 training offered pursuant to this section. Notice of denial of application shall include a clear and concise statement for which 6 7 the denial is based. CLEET may authorize up to two new entities each year to offer courses or training. Courses and training 8 9 offered by authorized entities shall consist of actual classroom 10 training at each entity location. All non-classroom training shall be provided at the CLEET training facility, unless approved 11 12 otherwise by CLEET.

Any courses or training offered pursuant to this section 13 В. shall meet minimum standards established for peace officers as set 14 15 forth in Section 3311 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes this 16 title and meet all applicable eligibility requirements for students to receive benefits pursuant to any of the federal G.I. bills. All 17 Prior to enrollment, all participants in any courses or training 18 offered pursuant to this section shall be required to submit all 19 background investigation requirements as set forth in Section 3311 20 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes this title. Costs associated 21 with the required background investigation requirements shall be the 22 23 responsibility of the student.

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C. Any state-supported technology center school in the State of
Oklahoma operating under the State Board of Career and Technology
Education or any higher education institution in this state shall be
authorized to set and administer their own rates for tuition and
fees for courses or training offered pursuant to this section.

D. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any materials 6 7 and records provided by CLEET to any institution of higher education or state-supported technology center school conducting a basic law 8 9 enforcement training shall remain the property of CLEET and retain 10 confidential status and shall not be released except under the conditions contained in Section 24A.8 of Title 51 of the Oklahoma 11 12 Statutes. In addition, any materials and records provided by any 13 institution of higher education or state-supported technology center school conducting basic law enforcement training to CLEET shall be 14 15 subject to these same limitations on release. Such materials and records include, but are not limited to, all records maintained 16 pursuant to Section 3311 of this title and records relating to any 17 employed or certified full-time officer, reserve officer, retired 18 officer or other person; teacher lesson plans, tests and other 19 teaching materials; and personal communications concerning 20 individual students except under the circumstances set forth in 21 Section 24A.8 of Title 51 of the Oklahoma Statutes. 22
