L8	A. Subject to the availability of funds, the Department of

23	firefighter, emergency medical and corrections communities impacted

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- 1 by trauma, cumulative stress, anxiety, addictions, death and suicide and the impact on their personal lives.
  - Qualified crisis intervention training entities shall В. provide peer support teams trained in crisis intervention and wellness strategies.
- C. Qualified crisis intervention training entities, as provided 6 for in this section, shall be required to be derived from the International Critical Incident Stress Foundation (ICISF) and shall employ the Critical Incident Stress Management (CISM) crisis 10 intervention process. All instructors that teach the Critical Incident Stress Management process shall be ICISF approved 12 instructors.
- D. Wellness strategies, required pursuant to this section, 13 shall include, but not be limited to, resilience trainings related 14 to resiliency for the job, emotional survival, substance abuse 15 prevention, suicide prevention, financial and relationship 16 strategies. Wellness training shall be taught using subject matter 17 experts' curriculum. 18
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021. 19
