L8	A. As used in this section, "biological sex" means the physical
L9	condition of being male or female, as identified at birth by that

B. Student restrooms and athletic changing facilities located in public schools and public charter schools that are intended to accommodate multiple individuals shall be designated as follows:

1. For the exclusive use of the male sex; or

A student in a public school or public charter school shall 3 use the restroom or athletic changing facility that corresponds to 4 the student's biological sex. 5 School district boards of education and governing boards of D. 6 charter schools shall not adopt a policy contrary to the provisions 7 of this section. 8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022. 9 SECTION 3.
