6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; making
8 certain acts unlawful; designating investigatory
9 office; providing for punishment; providing for
10 codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 593 of Title 21, unless there is
14 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. Any board, director, or elected official who has the
16 authority to enforce the Oklahoma Statutes and upon investigation is
17 discovered to have failed to enforce Oklahoma Statutes, shall be
18 held liable for damages caused, have their employment or appointment
19 terminated, and if remunerated, remuneration withdrawn.

20 B. Pursuant to the authority provided in Section 18f of the
21 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Office of the Attorney
22 General is authorized to investigate allegations that any board,
23 director, or elected official has failed to enforce Oklahoma
24 Statutes.
