6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to municipalities; providing
8 definition; directing certain restrooms and changing
9 facilities to be designated in certain manner;
10 requiring individuals to use the restroom or changing
11 facility that corresponds with his or her biological
12 sex; prohibiting municipalities from adopting certain
13 ordinance; providing for codification; providing an
14 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 13-117 of Title 11, unless there
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. As used in this section, "biological sex" means the physical
20 condition of being male or female, as identified at birth by that
21 individual's anatomy.

22 B. Public restrooms and changing facilities that are intended
23 to accommodate multiple individuals shall be designated as follows:

- 25 1. For the exclusive use of the male sex; or
 - 26 2. For the exclusive use of the female sex.
