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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5025.1 of Title 63, unless there
16	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. Subject to availability of funding, the Oklahoma Health Care
18	Authority shall reimburse providers under the state Medicaid program
19	for screening of children and adults for adverse childhood
20	experiences (ACEs).
21	B. If appropriate based on the ACE score, the provider shall
22	refer the individual for appropriate services which may include but
23	shall not be limited to counseling or other treatment.
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C. 1. The Authority shall seek any federal approval necessary
to implement this section.
2. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board shall promulgate
rules to implement the provisions of this section.
SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.
SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
