14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 5-106, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 5-106. A. The governing board of each school district
18	in Oklahoma is hereby designated and shall hereafter be known as the
19	board of education of such district. Except as otherwise provided
20	in this section, the superintendent of schools appointed and
21	employed by the board shall be the executive officer of the board
22	and shall perform duties as the board directs.
23	B. The board may contract with a superintendent for a term as
24 2 -	mutually agreed upon but not to exceed three (3) years beyond the

<sup>1</sup> fiscal year in which the contract is approved by the board and <sup>2</sup> accepted by the superintendent. The contract shall include all <sup>3</sup> other terms and conditions as agreed upon in writing by the board <sup>4</sup> and the superintendent.

5 C. Prior to entering into a written contract with a
6 superintendent, the board shall publicly disclose the names of the
7 final three candidates being considered for the position. If the
8 final number of candidates is fewer than three, the board shall
9 publicly disclose the names of the candidate(s).

<u>D.</u> The boards of two or more school districts may contract with
 one superintendent to serve as superintendent of the school
 districts as provided in Section 4 Section 5-106A of this act title.
 <del>D.</del> <u>E.</u> No board of a school district having <u>an</u> average daily
 membership (ADM) of fewer than five hundred (500) pupils shall be
 prohibited from allowing a superintendent to serve simultaneously as
 a principal.

<sup>17</sup>  $E \cdot F$ . The chief executive officer of the board of education of <sup>18</sup> a district in which a public developmental research school is <sup>19</sup> established shall be the director of the school appointed as <sup>20</sup> provided in Section 1210.577 of this title.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022. SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
