6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to sunset; amending 59 O.S. 2011,  
8 Section 2305, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter  
9 464, O.S.L. 2019 (59 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 2305),  
10 which relates to the Advisory Committee on  
11 Pedorthics; recreating the Committee; and modifying  
12 termination date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 2305, as  
14 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 464, O.S.L. 2019 (59 O.S. Supp.  
15 2020, Section 2305), is amended to read as follows:

16 Section 2305. A. There is hereby re-created, to continue until  
17 July 1, ~~2021~~ 2024, in accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma  
18 Sunset Law, an Advisory Committee on Pedorthics, which shall consist  
19 of five (5) voting members to be appointed by the State Board of  
20 Medical Licensure and Supervision to three-year terms ending  
21 December 31; provided, initial appointments shall be staggered such  
22 that two members are appointed for one (1) year, two members are  
23 appointed for two (2) years, and one member is appointed for three  
24 (3) years.

1 B. One member shall be a licensed physician who is a member of  
2 the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision. One member  
3 shall be a physician licensed to practice podiatric medicine by the  
4 Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners. One member shall be a member  
5 of the public who is a consumer of pedorthic services. Two members  
6 shall be pedorthists certified by the Board for Certification in  
7 Pedorthics or pedorthists licensed by the State Board of Medical  
8 Licensure and Supervision.

9 C. Members shall serve until their successors are appointed and  
10 qualified; provided, no member shall serve more than eight (8)  
11 consecutive years or two full terms, whichever is greater.

12 D. The Committee shall annually elect a chair and vice-chair  
13 from among the members. The chair or vice-chair and two other  
14 members shall constitute a quorum. Members shall be reimbursed from  
15 funds available to the State Board of Medical Licensure and  
16 Supervision pursuant to the State Travel Reimbursement Act.

17 E. 1. The Committee shall advise the Board on matters  
18 pertaining to pedorthics, including but not limited to:

- 19 a. scope and standards of practice,
- 20 b. licensure and registration requirements, examination  
21 requirements, exceptions thereto, renewal  
22 requirements, temporary licensure or registration, and  
23 endorsement or reciprocity requirements,

- c. methods and requirements for ensuring the continued competence of licensed and registered persons,
- d. grounds for probation, revocation or suspension of license or registration, reinstatement provisions,
- e. fees, and
- f. all other matters which may pertain to the practice of pedorthics.

2. The Committee shall review and make recommendations to the Board on all applications for licensure and registration.

3. The Committee shall assist and advise the Board in all hearings related to the enforcement of the Oklahoma Licensed Pedorthists Act.
