- 3. If such person carried at the time of such riot any species of firearms, or other deadly or dangerous weapon, or was disguised, such person shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary custody of the Department of Corrections not exceeding ten (10) years and not less than two (2) years;
- 4. If such person directed, advised, encouraged or solicited other persons, who participated in the riot to acts of force or violence, such person shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary custody of the Department of Corrections not exceeding twenty (20) years and not less than two (2) years; or
- 5. If such person willfully obstructed the normal use of any public street, highway or road within this state by impeding motor vehicle traffic, by standing or approaching motor vehicles thereon or by endangering the safe movement of motor vehicles or pedestrians traveling thereon, such person shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a term not exceeding two (2) years, or by a fine

    both such fine and imprisonment. In addition, the person shall be

    Statutes, under a reasonable belief that fleeing was necessary to

    protect the motor vehicle operator from serious injury or death.
