20	1. Incitement to riot as provided by Section 1320.2 of title 21
21	of the Oklahoma Statutes; or
22	2. Unlawful assembly as provided by Section 1320.3 of title 21
23	of the Oklahoma Statutes,
24	shall be immediately terminated from employment with the state.

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        B. Any person that has been convicted, in this state or any
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    other, whether upon a verdict or plea of guilty or upon a plea of
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    nolo contendere, or received a suspended sentence or any
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    probationary term, of the crimes in subsection A of this section
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    shall be ineligible for employment with any state, county,
