5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to public health and safety;
7 directing the Department of Public Safety to develop,
8 print and distribute carbon monoxide warning decals
9 and related instructions; directing the Department to
10 distribute decals and related instructions to the
11 Oklahoma Tax Commission; requiring the Department to
12 provide decals and related instructions to the public
13 free of charge; directing the Oklahoma Tax Commission
14 to mail decals and instructions under certain
15 circumstances; requiring warning decals on new and
16 used motors and vessels sold in the state; directing
17 new and used motor and vessel dealers to ensure
18 decals have been affixed to motors and vessels;
19 recognizing decals developed by manufacturers and
20 approved by the Department of Public Safety; allowing
21 owners of motors and vessels to request decals;
22 providing for codification; and providing an
23 effective date.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4223 of Title 63, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Department of Public Safety shall:

1. Develop, print and distribute carbon monoxide warning decals
that have been approved by the United States Coast Guard;

1 2. Develop, print and distribute instructions for affixing the
2 carbon monoxide warning decals on motors and vessels;

3 3. Provide carbon monoxide warning decals and related
4 instructions to the Oklahoma Tax Commission to be distributed by the
5 Commission upon approval and issuance of an original certificate of
6 title for a motor or vessel or whenever a certificate of title for a
7 motor or vessel is transferred; and

8 4. Provide, free of charge and upon request by the public,
9 carbon monoxide warning decals and related instructions.

10 B. Upon approving and issuing an original certificate of title
11 for a motor or vessel or when approving a request to transfer a
12 certificate of title, the Oklahoma Tax Commission shall mail with
13 the certificate of title a carbon monoxide warning decal and related
14 instructions.

15 C. A new or used motor or vessel, as defined in Section 4002 of
16 Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, other than personal watercraft,
17 as defined in Section 4201 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes,
18 sold within this state shall display a carbon monoxide warning
19 decal.

20 D. A new or used motor or vessel dealer shall ensure that a
21 carbon monoxide warning decal has been affixed to any motor or
22 vessel sold by the dealer before completing the sale of said motor
23 or vessel.

1 E. A carbon monoxide warning decal previously developed by a
2 manufacturer of motors or vessels satisfies the requirements of this
3 section if the decal has been approved by the Department of Public
4 Safety.

5 F. If a carbon monoxide warning decal has not previously been
6 affixed to a motor or vessel by the manufacturer or dealer, the
7 owner of a motor or vessel may request a carbon monoxide warning
8 decal from the Department of Public Safety and affix the decal
9 pursuant to the instructions provided by the Department.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
