13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 858-724, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 858-724. A. Before suspending or revoking any
16	certification, the Real Estate Appraiser Board shall notify the
17	appraiser in writing of any charges made at least thirty (30) days
18	prior to the date set for the hearing and shall afford the appraiser
19	an opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.
20	B. In any proceeding in which the Board is required to serve an
21	order on an individual, the Board may send such material to the
22	individual's address of record with the Board. If the order is
23	returned with a notation by the United States Postal Service
24	indicating that it is undeliverable for any reason, and the records

of the Board indicate that the Board has not received any change of address since the order was sent, as required by the rules of the Board, the order and any subsequent material relating to the same matter sent to the most recent address on file with the Board shall be deemed by the court as having been legally served for all purposes. The written notice may be served personally or by registered or certified mail to the last-known business and/or residence address of the appraiser.

- C. The Board shall have the power to subpoena and issue subpoenas duces tecum and to bring before it any person in this state, or to take testimony by deposition, in the same manner as prescribed by law in judicial proceedings in the courts of this state.
- D. In every case requiring the exercise of adjudicative
  authority, the Board shall provide that discovery be conducted
  pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Discovery Code, Sections
  3224 through 3237 of Title 12 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
