11 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

12 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of
13 Commerce; requiring that portions of certain funds be
14 utilized for certain purposes; providing budgeting
15 and expenditure limitations and procedures; providing
16 for lapse of funds under certain conditions; and
17 providing for noncodification.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
20 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

21 From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of
22 Commerce in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the
23 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars
24 (\$300,000.00) shall, under the direction of the Executive Director
of Commerce, be allocated to the Automotive Accelerator Program

1 within the Department. Such funds shall be used to attract original
2 equipment manufacturing and parts supply companies.

3 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
4 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

5 From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of
6 Commerce in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the
7 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Three Hundred Fifty Thousand
8 Dollars (\$350,000.00) shall, under the direction of the Executive
9 Director of Commerce, be allocated to the Rogers State University
10 TV's Distance Learning Classroom.

11 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
12 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

13 From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of
14 Commerce in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the
15 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Hundred Eighty-eight
16 Thousand One Hundred Eighty-seven Dollars (\$188,187.00) shall, under
17 the direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be used for the
18 Community Expansion of Nutrition Assistance Program.

19 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
20 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

21 From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of
22 Commerce in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the
23 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars
24

1 (\$60,000.00) shall, under the direction of the Executive Director of
2 Commerce, be allocated to support substate planning districts.

3 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
4 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

5 From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of
6 Commerce in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the
7 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Five Hundred Three Thousand
8 Two Hundred Fifty-eight Dollars (\$503,258.00) shall, under the
9 direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to the
10 Seminole State College's Rural Business and Resources Center.

11 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
12 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

13 From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of
14 Commerce in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the
15 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars
16 (\$100,000.00) shall, under the direction of the Executive Director
17 of Commerce, be allocated to the Department's Aerospace Commerce
18 Economic Services (ACES) Program. Such funds shall be used for
19 maintaining the program.

20 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
21 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

22 From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of
23 Commerce in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the
24 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Seven Hundred Twelve Thousand

1 Two Hundred Seventy-nine Dollars (\$712,279.00) shall, under the
2 direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to the
3 Oklahoma Film and Music Office within the Department. Such funds
4 shall be used for operational maintenance of the Office given its
5 transfer to the Department during the previous fiscal year.

6 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
7 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

8 From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of
9 Commerce in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the
10 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Four Hundred Thirty-seven
11 Thousand Nine Hundred Nineteen Dollars (\$437,919.00) shall, under
12 the direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to
13 the Department's Community Development program for the purpose of
14 supporting community action agencies.

15 SECTION 9. Appropriations made by this act, not including
16 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
17 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23) or may be
18 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 (hereafter FY-24).
19 Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only through June 30,
20 2023, and must be expended by November 15, 2023. Any funds
21 remaining after November 15, 2023, and not budgeted for FY-24, shall
22 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
23 year. Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered only through June
24 30, 2024. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2024, shall lapse

1 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
2 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
3 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-23, and not required to pay
4 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-24, after
5 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
6 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
7 from the FY-23 budget work program and after such revision has been
8 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
