Research Analysis

HB 1006 creates the Transparency in Health Care Prices Act which requires health care providers and facilities to make the prices for their most common health care services available to the public, either electronically or via their website. Health care facilities are also required to make common diagnosis and outpatient CPT codes public. The document must be updated at least annually.

This measure prohibits the review of healthcare prices by any agency. This act also prohibits interference in contracts between private parties.
