**Research Analysis**

HB 1010 provides for legislative intent regarding traumatic brain injuries.

The measure creates an Advisory Council on Traumatic Brain injury to provide guidelines and advice to agencies and other entities.

The measure specifies the duties and responsibilities of the Advisory council and requires it to provide an annual report of recommendations.

The State Department of Health is required to establish and maintain a central registry of persons who are hospitalized or die from traumatic brain injuries. The measure requires certain reporting from certain entities regarding traumatic brain injuries. It also requires an annual summary to be forwarded to the Advisory council by November 1 of each year.

The measure directs the State Department of Health to conduct an annual survey of nursing homes to determine the number of persons fifty-five (55) years or under who are there because of traumatic brain injuries.

Lastly, the measure requires the State Department of Health, the Department of Human Services, and the Department of Transportation Highway Safety Division to implement the programs recommended by the Advisory council. The Advisory council will be terminated on December 31, 2027.
