Research Analysis

HB 1098 authorizes retail spirits licensees to provide samples of alcoholic beverages on the licensed premises during business hours. Samples must be free to patrons and sold in their original factory-sealed packages or containers. Licensees are not required to offer samples.

Sample quantities are limited for each person during a 24-hour period as follows:

- Distilled spirits: not to exceed 0.25 ounces per sample and not to exceed four samples.
- Beer and wine: not to exceed 1 ounce per sample and not to exceed four samples.
