Research Analysis

Floor amendment 1 to HB 1198 requires the Legislature to review the 2020 Census P.L. 94-171 redistricting summary files released by the U.S. Census Bureau upon receipt. The amendment also directs the Legislature to adjust the district lines provided in the State House of Representatives Redistricting Act of 2021 if adjustments are necessary for compliance with the U.S. or state constitution. The Legislature will also consider adjustments to district lines in consideration of the population variance percentages in redistricting guidelines adopted by the House and Senate redistricting committees.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1198 in its current form anticipates the potential need for the Legislature to take certain actions “on or about August 2021”. The measure appears to contemplate the potential need for a Special Session during the 2022 Fiscal Year. Currently the anticipated combined cost of a special session for the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the State Senate is estimated to be approximately \$155,000 per week.
