## **Research Analysis**

HB 1564 prohibits the courts from extending the terms of tenancy and must grant possession immediately upon entry of judgment. The measure allows a landlord to immediately apply to the sheriff for enforcement of the right to possession upon the entry of a judgment. The measure limits the amount of a late payment fee to 15% of the monthly rent. The measure provides that the provisions in the Oklahoma Residential Landlord and Tenant Act are enforceable during a catastrophic health emergency.
