Fiscal Analysis

The committee substitute to HB 1715 repeals [Title 70, Section 1210.515](#) which relates to reading ability required for driver licenses or permit.

The measure repeals [Title 47 Section 6-107.3](#) relating to driver licenses and permit requirements.
