HB 1771 increases the number of members appointed to the State Governmental Technology Applications Review Board by the Speaker of the House and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate from two to three each.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1771 in its current form, increases by one the number of appointments to the State Governmental Technology Applications Review Board (GTARB), made each by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate. Existing statutory language provides for the reimbursement for travel expenses incurred by GTARB members. Such reimbursement is the responsibility of the appointing authority. For this reason HB 1771 is expected to result in increased travel reimbursement costs for the House of Representatives and the State Senate. Such increased costs are expected to be minimal.
