Fiscal Analysis

HB 1795, as introduced, modifies driver license revocation and reinstatement procedures for persons under the age of 20 that have committed any crime, violation, infraction, or traffic offense involving alcohol or controlled substances.

The measure is determined to have an impact on the Department of Transportation. The provisions of the measure may invoke the withholding of federal highway funds pursuant to 23 USC § 159. ODOT is currently analyzing the bill for a more detailed impact.
