HB 1993, as introduced, requires the Department of Transportation, if they determine a culvert to need repair or replacement, to bear the expense rather than the landowner.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1993 in its current form, makes the Department of Transportation (ODOT) responsible for certain repairs/replacements of culverts. Officials for ODOT estimate the per-unit-cost of repairing/replacing such culverts is approximately \$5,000 per culvert.

ODOT estimates there are approximately 500,000 such culverts statewide. There is no estimate as to the expected number of such culverts that would need to be replaced annually.
