**Research Analysis**

HB2122, as introduced, creates the “Oklahoma Cocktails To Go Act of 2021”. The measure allows establishments holding a mixed beverage license to sell cocktails to-go in a sealed tamper-proof container, as long as certain requirements are met:

- If delivered, the cocktail must be delivered by an employee of the retail establishment who is at least 21 years old, and can verify the age of the person buying the cocktail.
- If delivered or picked up, the cocktail must be placed in the trunk of the vehicle, or in the rear compartment of the vehicle if there is no trunk.
- The sealed container must include a label containing the ingredients, name and address of the establishment, and the volume of the cocktail.

Third-party deliveries of cocktails are prohibited. Entities holding a license to manufacture alcoholic liquors or beverages are prohibited from being able to sell cocktails to-go.

The measure requires all establishments authorized to sell cocktails to-go, to be held responsible for violations of any alcoholic beverage law or rule.

Lastly, the measure is only to be in effect for one year.
