## **Research Analysis**

HB 2184, as introduced, changes the Highway Construction Materials Technician Certification Board to an advisory board under the Department of Transportation. Appointments to the board would be made by the Secretary of Transportation, and members of the board would serve at the Secretary's pleasure. The board's rulemaking authority over the training of construction inspectors, construction supervisors, and registration of highway construction materials technicians would be transferred to the Transportation Commission. The advisory board would receive administrative and financial support from the Oklahoma Department of Transportation.
